The program is also available in French by clicking on the "EN" button


Teacher View Features:

#1 – Modules:

All the modules are unlocked and available for viewing (it does not have the video broken into parts – like the student view does).

#2 – Instructor Tools:

This is where you find access to the workbook with the answer key, interactive tools, like the budget calculator and other instructor resources.



#3 – Statistics:

This is where you can track student progress and view the test scores.

#4 Add Users:

This is where you can create student accounts.



Add Users

- This is where you create student accounts. *Students have life-time access. When students graduate, they can add a personal email.*

Step 1:

- Create an excel file with 3 columns (*column header is: first name, last name and school email*).
- You can use the sample provided by clicking "Download Sample" or create your own.
- Save this file as a Comma Delimited (.csv) file.

Step 2:

- Click Upload File.
- Choose the CSV file you just created.
- Then click Upload Users

Each student will receive a welcome email from us with their login details immediately. Be sure to tell students to check their junk mail if they don't see the email.


1. Go to www.enrichedacademy.com

Homepage


- When a student logs in it will show the current module they are working on.
- Clicking **Continue** will play the video.
- Clicking **Module List** will open the full module list; however, they are locked. Videos unlock once students watch the video and complete the quiz passing at 75%. Students can retake the quiz as many times as needed.
- Students have quick access to 3 of the tools from this page in a user-friendly version (Debt, Net Worth Tracker & Savings Calculator).
- Students can also click “Workbook, Calculator & Tools” to access additional tools and the Online Workbook.

Video Features


- After a student clicks Continue, it will open the current video.
- Each video has closed captioning and speed control
- The videos are chunked into smaller sections. Unlike the videos in your teacher view.
